

Plum Trees

Mount Royal –

Plums ripen in late August. A freestone, blue plum with tender, juicy flesh. Considered to be the best blue cultivar in WI and MN. Excellent for dessert, jam and preserves. Self-pollinating.

Zone 4-8, Height 8-12'

Toka –

Plums ripen in mid-August. A clingstone, red, medium sized plum with rich flavor and an apricot color. Toka is one of the best pollinators for other plums. Requires a pollinator.

Zone 3-8, Height 15-20'

Pear Trees

Ure Pear –

Pears ripen in mid-August. A yellow-green, very juicy pear. Good for eating and canning. Requires a pollinator (Golden Spice Pear).

Zone 3-7

Tawara Asian Pear –

Pears ripen in August –September. A dark tan to light brown fruit with a crispy texture tasting like a cross of apples and pears. Good for eating and canning. Requires a pollinator (Seckle, Bosc or Bartlett are best).

Zone 4-7

Apple Crisp

- 6-8 apples, peeled, cored and thinly sliced
- ½ c. sugar
- ½ c. brown sugar
- 1 tsp. cinnamon
- ½ tsp. nutmeg
- 1 c. Old-Fashioned oats
- ½ c/ all-purpose flour
- ½ c. butter, cold
- 1 Tbsp. vanilla extract

Preheat oven to 400°. Spread sliced apples in a 9x13 glass pan. Mix the sugar, cinnamon, and nutmeg. Sprinkle over the apples. Combine brown sugar, oats and flour in bowl. Next combine the brown sugar, flour, and oats. Cut in the cold butter 1 tablespoon at a time until crumbly. Mixture will be dry. Add vanilla extract to mixture. Sprinkle evenly over apples. Bake uncovered for 25-40 minutes depending on the thickness of apple slices.

Serve with ice cream.

Fruit Trees



Apple Trees

Courtland -

Ripens mid-late season. A medium, bright red apple with a white flesh and slight tropical flavor. Great for eating and cooking. Requires a pollinator (Honeycrisp, KinderKrisp or McIntosh).

Zone 4-7

Honeycrisp -

Ripens in late September. A well balanced sweet apple that is extremely crisp and juicy. Great for eating and storage. Requires a pollinator (KinderKrisp, McIntosh or Courtland).

Zone 4-7

KinderKrisp -

Ripens late August. Exceptional flavor and crisp similar to its parent 'Honeycrisp' accept a smaller fruit. Great for fresh eating and snacks. Requires a pollinator (Courtland, Honeycrisp or McIntosh).

Zone 4-7

McIntosh -

Ripens in late September. Solid bright red skin, with active flavor and a medium storage life. Great for eating and baking. Requires a pollinator (Courtland, Honeycrisp or KinderKrisp).

Zone 4-7

Cherry Trees

Mesabi -

Ripens early July. A long stemmed, red, sour cherry with the sugar content between a 'Bing' and pie cherry. Self-pollinating.

Zone 4-8, Height 10'-14'

Montgomery -

Ripens late June. A large, red, tart, firm and juicy cherry. Highly productive. Great for pie and preserves. Self-pollinating.

Zone 5-9, Height 12'-18'

North Star -

Ripens late June. A very productive dwarf tree with red fruit and small stones. A sour pie cherry. Self-pollinating.

Zone 4-8, Height 8'-10'

Sweet Cherry Pie -

Ripens mid-July. A sour pie cherry with a sweet flavor (not quite for fresh eating). Excellent for jams, jelly and pie. Self-pollinating.

Zone 3-7, Height 15'

Peach Trees

Contender -

Ripens mid to late-August. A bright yellow fleshed, sweet, extra juicy, freestone peach. Cold hardy and can handle spring frost. Great for eating, baking, canning, and freezing. Self-pollinating.

Zone 4-8, Height 12'-15'

Redhaven -

Ripens July to early August. A red, golden yellow, freestone peach with a firm and smooth texture. A round, medium sized fruit with a fine flavor. Hardy and disease resistant. Heavily set fruit and must be thinned for fruit to reach size. Self-pollinating.

Zone 5-8, Height 15'-20'

Reliance -

Ripens July to early August. The hardest yellow, freestone peach. A medium size, juicy, soft, with fair flavor. Self-pollinating.

Zone 5-8, Height 18'-20'

Saturn -

Ripens July to early August. A freestone, flat, sweet, yellow peach with white flesh. Self-pollinating.

Zone 5-9, Height 12'-15'
